

**Special School Board Meeting Minutes**  
**Thursday, December 3, 2015**

A special meeting of the Stanley-Boyd Board of Education was held on Thursday, December 3, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. in the High School Library.

Richard Vircks, Board President, called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Roll call: Lance Carlson, Mike Henke, Jackie Holub, Chad Verbeten, Richard Vircks and Jeff Boie. Also present were the student and his parents, Mr. Hall, Mrs. Mahal, Mr. Ludy, Mrs. Bacha (intern Kelly Hughes), Mrs. Goodman and Mr. Jones.

**Student Expulsion**

In the interest of full disclosure, Board Member Chad Verbeten notified the student and parents that he is employed as the Assistant District Attorney for Chippewa County and is married to one of the Stanley-Boyd Middle School teachers. He indicated he would abstain from voting on this matter if warranted.

The student and his parents previously requested closed session by phone.

Motion by Henke, seconded by Holub, to convene in closed session pursuant to sections 19.85(1)(a) and 19.85(1)(f), Wis. Stats., for the purpose of holding a student expulsion hearing and for the purpose of deliberating in closed session concerning the truth or falsity of the charges, if not admitted as well as the appropriate penalty for the alleged misconduct if the charges are sustained. On a roll call vote, all present voted "Yes". Motion carried.

Mr. Hall asked if each board member believed they could make a decision regarding the issue before them based solely on the evidence presented at this hearing. On roll call, all present affirmed.

The charges were read and the case was presented.

With the exception of Mr. Hall, the board excused all from the room to begin deliberation.

The statutory grounds for expulsion have been met and the interest of the school demands his expulsion. Motion carried on a 3 – 2 vote.
