Earlier this year we launched Solar*Connect Community, a flexible, local way for our customers to increase the amount of renewable energy they use. Thanks to customers like you, we're well on our way to fully subscribing our two community solar gardens. In fact, the program is currently about 70 percent subscribed.

You are among more than 90 Solar*Connect Community "Founding Members" who have made the commitment to power some or all of your energy with clean, carbon-free solar power.

Like you, we are excited to see the community solar gardens take shape. And, while we had expected the gardens – one in the city of Eau Claire and the other in the greater La Crosse area – to be operational by year's end, that will not be the case. Instead we anticipate that construction will begin in early 2017 as construction preparation is finalized, and the gardens will be generating electricity in the first quarter of 2017.

You will receive 25 years of monthly bill credits based on your subscription's portion of the solar energy production of the garden. These credits will begin about a month after the solar garden is in service.

If you still have a subscription balance, no worries. We will send an invoice for the remaining balance once the expected in-service date for the solar garden is determined. If you would like to make your final payment in 2016 or have specific requests, please contact us. Along with our developer partner Pristine Sun, we remain fully committed and dedicated to this exciting project and will keep you updated along the way.
