The Stanley - Boyd School District would like to inform staff, students, parents, and the public of the district's indoor environmental quality (IEQ) management plan. In compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), this is notice that the Stanley-Boyd School District has an Asbestos Management Plan at the school district office. The plan is available for inspection by the public, parents, and district employees. The district performs six month periodic surveillance of asbestos in May and November and full re-inspections every three years. For more information please contact the district office.
