Thank you for meeting with us to discuss our mutual concerns with financially solidifying the Open Doors Program so it can continue to provide for our students as well as provide a viable option for our Districts.

We agreed that I would send you a summary letter of what we agreed upon so there are no surprises. Those agreements are listed out below. I don't see any reason to do any sort of signed agreement so if you don't have issues with any of the bulleted points below, know that Stanley-Boyd will bill you accordingly beginning with the 2016-17 school year.

- Cadott, Cornell, and Thorp School Districts will reserve a "seat" in the program by financially committing to one student every day. That amount will be equal to the open enrollment tuition amount for the year. Stanley-Boyd will bill each District for that amount at the end of each school year.
- Additional students beyond the first student will be billed at a daily rate based on actual attendance. That daily rate will be determined by dividing the open enrollment amount by 180. Attendance will be kept at Open Doors and Districts will be billed at the end of the year.
- SBSB will use the additional dollars from the reserved seats to purchase a second aide position for Open Doors. Thereby, if a District should desire to no longer participate in the program, notice of that decision would be provided to SBSB in writing by June 30 of the previous school year.
