An all school lockdown drill was completed at the main building on Friday, November 19th. Prior to the drill, a brief description of why we practice the drill was read to everyone in the building via an intercom announcement. This announcement also gave students valuable information in case they were not in their classroom during the beginning of the drill.

The expectation is that doors are closed and locked, classrooms are dark and quiet with no students visible. When we walked around to check doors, listen for noises and observe to see if students were in view of the window in the door, most high school staff and students met expectations. In four classrooms, doors were locked and closed but students could be heard (and in one of those rooms, students could be seen). One teacher did not lock the door but no students were visible or heard. One locker room door was unlocked. Mr. Schrader checked the 100 and SPED hallways. I checked the entryway, gym, art, shop, music/Spanish wing and 200 hallway. All areas were secure; no students or staff were in the hallways.

Kimm Severson conducted a practice drill at Open Doors at 9:00 am on Thursday, December 18th. She talked with students about barricading, fleeing, and distracting an intruder. They discussed exit routes and secured themselves in the bathroom as well as various side rooms for the Open Doors version of the all school drill.
